HOW DOES THE ASSOCIATION BENEFIT THE SCHOOL?

In the last year alone, our fundraising efforts have provided:

- Part funding the regeneration of the School's playground with new equipment
- National Curriculum based Lego Workshops for KS1 and KS2
- Interactive Smart Touchscreen for the ICT Suite
- Year 3 and 4 (144 pupils) trip to the Bedford Faith Tour

Our current fundraising goals are:

- To raise money for Interactive Smart Touchscreens for all classrooms
- To raise money for Flitwick Lower School to be able to have its own Forest School.

In addition to this we offset the cost of some school trips for example the coaches for the year 4 residential school trip to Grafham Water.

We also provide and pay for the School's book bags for all new pupils.

HOW CAN I GET INVOLVED?

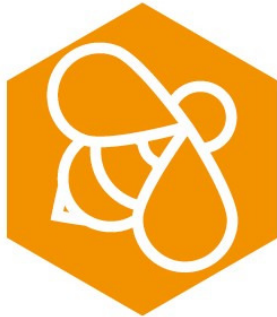
You can help the Association and ultimately your children in two ways:
