Jump when you hear a word that rhymes. <i>Remember: rhyming words sound the same at the end!</i> • Tell the story of The Three Little Pigs using different voices for each character. Try including some home-made sound effects! • Stand outside and listen for 5 different sounds. Did you hear the same sounds as each other?
