<p>This week we have sailed to Galapagos! We saw many creatures along our way, 'Plodding Tortoises, Clacking Albatrosses, Fishing Booby Birds, Skipping Lava Crabs, Courting Frigate Birds, Sleeping Sea Lions and Crawling Iguanas'. The children shared the story throughout the week and wrote sentences about each animal, using adjectives and verbs. In PE, the children explored the movements of the Galapagos creatures and created some music to accompany the song 'We're sailing to Galapagos'. In Maths, we have been looking at the language of time e.g. before, next, after, finally, yesterday, tomorrow and today. We have also tried hard to remember the days of the week and the months of the year and used the vocabulary linked to ordinal numbers e.g. first, second, third.</p>
