What a busy week! The children were absolute super stars in their performance of 'Whoops-A-Daisy Angel' and should be very proud of themselves! This week, we have continued our Topic learning by exploring The Great Fire of London. The children discussed what happened with their talk partners and then sequenced the story, recalling the events. They also mixed paints to create a scene of the fire like the Creative Dragon Learning Buddy. During our discussions, we sorted pictures into 'then' and 'now', looking at things that have changed such as transport, fire fighters and the Royal Family. The children then thought carefully about 'why things are better now than in the past' referring back to the pictures to support their explanations. In Maths, we looked at 2D shapes. The children talked about their properties and also went on a shape hunt around the learning environments. They also looked at repeating patterns and applied their learning by continuing the given pattern and creating their own.
