

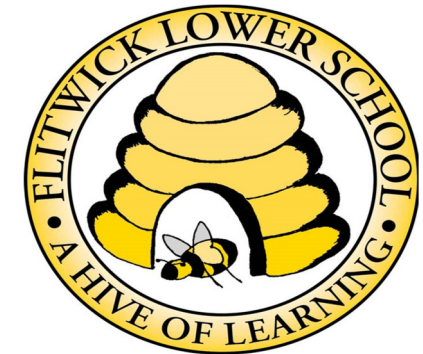
CODE OF CONDUCT
